General Rules and Conditions

The Victorian Arabian Summer Show is conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd. Competitors are responsible for becoming familiar with all sections of these rules as they form a part of the conditions of Entry for this show. Copies of the **2016** rules can be obtained through the AHSA Ltd or downloaded from AHSA website.

Unregistered or un-transferred horses will be accepted at close of entry but will not be catalogued. It is up to the owner/leasee to prove to the show committee that the horse is registered in compliance prior to the class and provide the exhibit's registration number. In the event that no proof is forthcoming the exhibit will not be eligible for competition and the entry fees will be forfeited.

Conditions of Entry

The show committee shall have the power without assigning any reasons to:

- Reject or cancel any entry at any time.
- Cancel any event or class.
- Order the removal of any exhibitor from the venue.
- Transfer an exhibit or exhibitor from any class to any other class.
- Change the running order of classes in the event of obvious clashes.
- If there are insufficient/sufficient numbers, classes may be combined or divided.

TONIMBUK RULES

- Facilities are to be left in a clean and undamaged condition. Fees for cleaning and/or repair will be invoiced to those concerned.
- Competitors agree to follow any directions or instructions given by any person appointed by the THTC to manage and control TEC and to follow any directions displayed in TEC.
- All dogs are to remain on a lead whilst on the venue and are not to enter the indoor arenas under any circumstances.
- Children at the event must be properly controlled and supervised at all times.
- Stables & camping **MUST** be booked for events via nominate.com.au. A bond is to be paid and will be refunded via nominate, when the cleanliness of the stable is inspected and approved.
- The use of straw is **NOT** permitted at TEC. This applies to all facilities including all stables, riding arenas and car park but does not apply to the cross country course.
- Competitors agree to behave appropriately at all times, anyone not doing so will be asked to leave. Immediately vacates the Tonimbuk Equestrian Centre.

Protests and Appeals

A Protests and Appeals Committee will be appointed prior to the show. All protests must be made in writing and a fee of \$50.00 must accompany each protest. This fee will be refunded unless the protest is deemed frivolous. Protests must be lodged within the hour of the class or event taking place.

The Committee Accepts No Responsibility

It is the policy of the Committee to see all due care is taken to protect property, but the Committee shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of defect, accident, negligence, however arising.

Awards - Champion, Reserve Champion, Top 5, unless otherwise stated.

ENTRIES - **ALL** entries (poster or emailed) **MUST** include **ALL** required paperwork (insurance forms, copy of Membership Card ,copy of exhibit registration & non-pro declaration if required.

IF ANY OF THE REQUIRED PAPERWORK IS MISSING A \$20 PENALTY APPLIES AND WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

Entries will be processed **ONLY** after funds appear in the VAHA Inc. account. Funds **MUST** be received by Friday 27/1/17 or higher fees apply. No exceptions. Please supply a copy of the bank receipt with entries.

INSURANCE – The Liability Declaration form must be completed by every person handling a horse in OR out of the arenas. Exhibitors and persons handling horses without insurance as outlined on the Liability Declaration form must also complete the Registered Participant Application form and pay the relevant fees.

All exhibitors must be current financial members of AHSA Ltd.

Any person (spectator or competitor) causing annoyance by loud comments on Judges' decisions or by unseemly conduct or by insulting behaviour will, after being cautioned, be named over the Public Address system. Should the unacceptable behaviour persist, forfeiture of any awards already gained and denial of further participation at this or any future VAHA Inc. event may result.

Entry fees will not be refunded once the entry has been accepted regardless of the reason. In some instances, a substitute horse may be brought in place of an unregistered or scratched horse by prior arrangement with the Secretary. Please do not ask for a refund as refusal may offend.

Non Pro Classes (Halter and Ridden)

Must complete the NON PRO Declaration.

Novice Ridden Please refer to the 2016 AHSA rule book.

Open to horses which have not won an OPEN RIDDEN CLASS or Championship at an A.H.S.A. Affiliate show, Royal Show, EA Show, Agricultural Show, SHC Show, or be officially graded above Novice level in dressage for the grading of the event you are entering. Horses must be shown in a Snaffle bit. A hacking cane or whip is permitted. Spurs are optional. One horse/one rider only. The horse will be judged on quality, manners and Paces.

Newcomers Class will not have competed in a previous season under Saddle. Performance qualifications are not required and entry is open regardless of prior placings. A Snaffle bit is compulsory. Whip, cane and spurs are optional.

Prize money for the Newcomer Class,

from 65% of entries from each newcomer class. Champion - 30% Reserve Champion - 20% Top 5 placing 5% each.

The Ajay 50% + Arabian Derivative Jackpot Class

A halter class for Derivatives with 50% or more Arabian blood.

Prize money for the above classes will be made of the following from 60% of entries.

1st - 30%, 2nd 20%, 3rd 10 %.

HALF ARABIAN CLASSES

Half Arabian registered horses are only eligible to compete in the Half Arabian classes where provided & ARE eligible for the relevant Supreme Championships.

ARABIAN PERFORMANCE INDEX CLASSES - All horses MUST be 3 years old or over.

API registered horses are eligible to compete in the API halter, API saddle, any other Derivative classes and miscellaneous classes where no registry is specified in the class description. (e.g Handler/Rider classes Arabian/Arabian Derivative miscellaneous classes). API horses are **INELIGIBLE** for Supreme Led Derivative Awards and Supreme Ridden Exhibit.

Newcomer and Ajay Arabian Jackpot \$30.00 (NO ENTRIES ON DAY)

Youth Exhibitors Package (17 Years and under)

1 Horse / 1 Rider rule applies **\$70.00** (all Youth and ordinary classes EXCLUDING open Halter, Non Pro Classes, Ajay Award or Newcomers.) These may be entered separately.

Performance Package \$100.00

1 Horse / 1 Rider applies, any number of performance classes. Does **NOT** include Open Halter, Newcomers or Ajay Award. These may be entered separately.
